

Turn the whole season into your easiest fundraiser.

Run a football squares raffle for your cause — one ticket plays every game all season. Patrons buy paper tickets and track them from their phones, the numbers draw fairly when sales lock, and ticket sales go straight to your cause.

A registered charitable raffle — tickets sold in person, with state filing (e.g. CA CT-NRP-1 / CT-NRP-2) tracked for you. Rules vary by state.

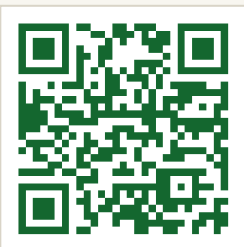

WHY IT'S BUILT FOR YOUR CAUSE

- A whole season, not one game.**
 Fundraise all season — not just one game. One ticket rides every game on the slate, and each quarter is a fresh drawing. Prizes donated or group-funded — never a platform cut of ticket sales.
- No money through the platform.**
 Sell paper tickets in person and collect however you like — cash, check, Venmo, card reader. Sunday Squares just records who paid.
- Fair and verifiable.**
 The draw is sealed before anyone picks a ticket and revealed when sales lock, so anyone can confirm nothing was rigged.
- Look legit, run on autopilot.**
 State-filing tracker (e.g. CA CT-NRP-1 / CT-NRP-2), printable tickets, live scores that auto-pick winners, treasurer report — re-run next season in a click.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1 Register & create your group.**
 Free — register your raffle with your state, then set up in minutes.
- 2 Build a raffle.**
 One game or a full season. Set the ticket price and prizes.
- 3 Sell tickets in person.**
 Sell paper tickets and share a link + QR so patrons track them; they pay you at the sale.
- 4 Lock draws the numbers.**
 Fair, published draw when sales close — then scores sync live.
- 5 The score draws the winners.**
 Each quarter's score picks the winning ticket automatically — it lights up live and the winner gets texted. Ticket sales go to your cause.
